“Trick” No 2: Rock out to the “Let’s Get Wicked” show

The Theater in the Wild will get even wilder this year, and the “Let’s Get Wicked” musical is getting a truly spooky twist. Cruella de Vil from *One Hundred and One Dalmatians* has decided to leave her wicked pack to dominate the “Wicked Fun Party Zone,” while Maleficent, the Mistress of Evil from *Sleeping Beauty*, will be joined by her Dark Fey fairies to take control of the stage through music! Her dark powers will engulf everything in projections of black thorns.



Not to be outdone, Ursula the sea witch from *The Little Mermaid*, the evildoer Dr. Facilier of *The Princess and the Frog*, the bully Gaston from *Beauty and the Beast* and Mother Gothel from *Tangled* will perform for guests, singing and dancing to many songs with new musical elements.

Mickey Mouse, Minnie Mouse, Donald Duck, Daisy Duck, Goofy, Pluto and Chip ‘n’ Dale will also be dressing up in their Halloween costumes to greet guests at “Halloween Time Festival Gardens” in Fantasyland. Winnie the Pooh and Friends will also pose in their Halloween outfits. Meet them all this Halloween!

Next, head on over to the Iron Man and Spider-Man-shaped pumpkin head candy stations to complete your trick-or-treat mission!

Heads up foodies — there are all kinds of spooky #eatertainment experiences this Halloween. Cruella has extended her nefarious influence on the Karibuni Marketplace, with seasonal limited alcoholic drinks at “Wicked Potions 'N' Brews.” More non-alcoholic options are available for guests to cool down.

1. use the “LeaveHomeSafe” app, fulfill the “Vaccine Pass” vaccination requirement and are not holding the “Red Code” or “Amber Code” as required by law upon entering designated premises including the Park and restaurants for dine-in. 2. purchase their tickets in advance and make park visit reservations up to 90 days in advance of their visit, via the Hong Kong Disneyland reservation website;
3. confirm that they do not have a fever or any respiratory symptoms.
4. go through temperature screening before entering the Park; and
5. wear a face mask during their visit, except when consuming food or drinks at catering premises.
